Who can apply?	Open to both academic and professional service staff	For children up to the age of 13 (or 16 for a child with a disability and/or long term illness).	
	Open to job sharers and part-time employees		
How do I apply?	 Discuss the dates/duration with your Head of Dept/Line Manager Submit a letter of application to HR; with a copy to your Head of Dept/Line Manager 	Include the intended date of commencement, duration, manner, birth certificate of child, signature	
How does it affect my salary?	You do not get paid while on Parental Leave	You do not contribute towards your pension entitlements while on Parental Leave	
Is my annual leave affected?	Your annual leave is not affected; you maintain your full annual leave entitlement		
How are bank holidays accounted for?	You are still entitled to public holidays during parental leave and these should be added at the end of the leave period.		
What happens if I am sick during the leave?	Can be paused if the employee becomes sick and unable to care for the child
