

## How to get to MIC from Shannon Airport

### Option 1-transfer

Students will have the option to avail of transfers direct from Shannon Airport on their arrival. This requires the students to liaise directly with the International Office prior to departure. For more information, contact [international@mic.ul.ie](mailto:international@mic.ul.ie).

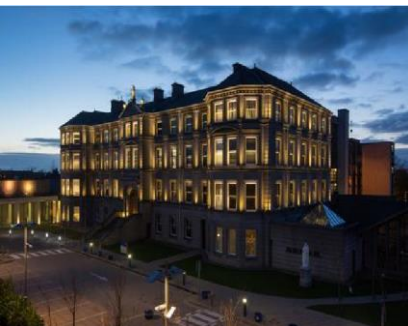
### Option 2-Bus

Bus Eireann bus 51, X51 or 343 depart from the arrivals gate at Shannon Airport to Limerick Bus station in the city. The bus stop is outside the main terminal. The journey will last approximately 30 minutes. Tickets can be booked online at Bus Eireann [Expressway](#) costing €8/€9 when booked online.

This service ends at Limerick bus station, approximately a [20 minute walk from MIC](#). A taxi from the bus station to Mary Immaculate College will cost approximately €10.

### Option 3-Taxi

A taxi direct from Shannon Airport to Mary Immaculate College would cost approximately €55. Here is a link to [taxi numbers in Limerick](#) or you can use a taxi rank at the airport. If you wish to book a taxi at the airport in advance of your arrival see [link here](#).



## How to get to MIC from Dublin Airport

### Option 1-Eireagle Bus

There is a non-stop express bus from Dublin Airport to Arthurs Quay. This bus departs from Zone 10 outside Dublin Airport. The bus trip lasts approximately 2hrs and 25 minutes. It departs from Dublin Airport every 2 hours from 0.30 am until 22.00am at night. Tickets can be booked online at [Eireagle.com](http://Eireagle.com) costing €20 when booked online but if paying cash/card on the bus is €25. This service ends at Arthurs Quay, Limerick and is approximately 25 minute walk from [Arthur's Quay Bus Stop to MIC](#).

### Option 2- Dublin Coach

This service runs daily from Dublin Airport to Arthurs Quay in Limerick. The bus departs hourly at half past the hour from 'Coach Park' outside Dublin Airport between 0.30 and 23:30 This service lasts approximately 3 hours.

*Please note that this service involves changing bus at the Red Cow LUAS for the M7 Express Service (Bus 300 Ennis/Limerick).* This bus services has an app called Big Green Bus that you can download [here](#). Tickets can be booked online at [Dublincoach.ie](http://Dublincoach.ie) costing €20 but can pay on the bus with cash/card where the charge is €25. It is approximately 25 minute walk from [Arthur's Quay Bus Stop to MIC](#).



## How to get to MIC from Cork Airport

### Option 1

City Link bus 251/251X service runs from Cork Airport to Limerick – Henry Street. The bus departs from the main terminal in Cork Airport. This bus journey is approximately 2 hours and 15 mins. It departs Cork Airport every 2-3 hours from 07:30 to 19:45. Tickets can be booked online at [Citylink.ie](http://Citylink.ie) costing €17 but if paying with cash/card on the bus the rates increase to €19. It is approximately an eight minute walk from bus stop on [Henry Street to MIC](#).
